



CASE STUDY

Background:

Between 2022 and 2024, attorney Tim H. represented a major fruit producer exporting to the United States in a commercial litigation case in state court. The dispute involved an Operator of a cold storage warehouse facility in a port. The Producer claimed over \$2 million in compensatory damages caused by the lost market value of its produce while stored by the Operator at the facility.
